# Raising Money for Solar Panels:

Dear Friends and Patrons,

### HELP US KEEP \$62,000 IN OUR COMMUNITY!



Our libraries were fortunate enough to receive a construction grant of \$62,697, before New York State virtually shut down because of Covid-19. This construction grant is contingent on us contributing 25% of the cost of the project. Our project consists of an \$83,596 Solar

Electric Panel Installation, High Efficiency AC/Heat Pump System, and Signage. We are expected to contribute \$20,899 of which we have currently secured roughly \$9,240. In order to receive the grant money and bring this project to fruition, we need to raise another \$11,659. We ask you to help us meet this challenge! Our grant will bring renewable energy to our community and allow our libraries to stay open to make a difference now and for future generations.
